**Explanation of Responses:**

- Each Restricted Stock Unit ("RSU") represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Issuer's Class A Common Stock.
- The sale of shares is for the sole purpose of covering the Reporting Person's tax liability with respect to the settlement of RSUs.
- The reported price in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$13.8600 to \$13.9000 per share, inclusive. The Reporting Person undertakes to provide to the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range set forth in this footnote.
- The RSUs vest as to 6.25% of the total shares quarterly, commencing November 15, 2020, with 100% of the total shares vested on August 15, 2024, subject to the reporting person's provision of service to the issuer on each vesting date.
- The RSUs vest as to 6.25% of the total shares quarterly, commencing November 15, 2021, with 100% of the total shares vested on August 15, 2025, subject to the reporting person's provision of service to the issuer on each vesting date.
- The RSUs vest as to 8.33% of the total shares quarterly, commencing November 15, 2021, with 100% of the total shares vested on August 15, 2024, subject to the reporting person's provision of service to the issuer on each vesting date.

7. The RSUs vest as to 6.25% of the total shares quarterly, commencing May 15, 2022, with 100% of the total shares vested on February 15, 2026, subject to the reporting person's provision of service to the issuer on each vesting date.

8. The RSUs vested as to 25% of the total shares on May 17, 2021, then 6.25% of the total shares vest quarterly on the first trading day on or after each of February 15, May 15, August 15 and November 15, with 100% of the total shares vested on May 15, 2024, subject to the reporting person's provision of service to the issuer on each vesting date.
