



## VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

To: The Stakeholders of Peloton Interactive, Inc.

Apex Companies, LLC (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reported by Peloton Interactive, Inc. (Peloton) and Precor, a wholly owned subsidiary, for the period stated below. This verification opinion declaration applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions is the sole responsibility of Peloton and Precor. Peloton and Precor are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions statement in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions reported, and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG emissions statement based on the verification. Verification activities applied in a limited level of assurance verification are less extensive in nature, timing and extent than in a reasonable level of assurance verification.

- Operational Control
- Worldwide
- Exclusions from the scope of Peloton and Precor's GHG emissions statement:
  - Refrigerant emission sources

**Types of GHGs:** CO<sub>2</sub>, N<sub>2</sub>O, CH<sub>4</sub>

### **Peloton GHG Emissions Statement:**

- **Scope 1:** 1,894 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Location-Based):** 3,660 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Market-Based):** 1,052 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent

### **Precor GHG Emissions Statement:**

- **Scope 1:** 2,429 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Location-Based):** 988 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Market-Based):** 284 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent

**Criteria against which verification was conducted:**

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scopes 1 and 2)
- WRI/ WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3)

**Reference Standard:**

- ISO 14064-3 Second edition 2019-4: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements

**Level of Assurance and Qualifications:**

- Limited
- This verification used a materiality threshold of  $\pm 5\%$  for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.

**GHG Verification Methodology:**

Evidence-gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Peloton, Precor and their consultant;

- Review of documentary evidence produced by Peloton and Precor and their consultant;
- Review of Peloton and Precor data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis and review of information used to determine GHG emissions; and
- Audit of sample data used by Peloton and Precor to determine GHG emissions.

**Verification Opinion:**

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions statement shown above:

- is not materially correct and is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2), and WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3).

It is our opinion that Peloton and Precor have established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data for determination of these GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.

**Statement of independence, impartiality and competence**

Apex is an independent professional services company that specializes in Health, Safety, Social and Environmental management services including assurance with over 30 years history in providing these services.

No member of the verification team has a business relationship with Peloton, Precor, or their Directors or Managers beyond that required of this assignment. We conducted this verification independently and to our knowledge there has been no conflict of interest.
